Correct/Incorrect: I

Grammar Error: sentence fragment

Correction: Due to the increased enrollment of students at Okanagan College, the library

is getting busier.

Correct/Incorrect: I

Grammar Error: comma splice

Correction: Frank was invited to the Business Awards Ceremony this year <u>as</u> he is a very astute student with a promising future.

Correct/Incorrect: *I* 

Grammar Error: run-on sentence

Correct/Incorrect: *I* 

Grammar Error: comma splice
